Report Back

- Role of Iwi leaders working group –
 - to provide advice to government on whether proposals likely to be seen as fair and reasonable by Iwi Māori;
 - advisory role is not intended to usurp the mana and Treaty partner status of each Iwi and hapū;
 - advice is provided early in the policy development
 - to distribute information to Iwi katoa for their consideration;
 - Mechanisms- Iwi Chairs Forum and Hui a Iwi

- June– Hui a Iwi
