n behalf of Rangitāne Tū Mai Rā we would like to acknowledge one of our very own wahine rangatira Mavis Mullins who will be formally inducted into the National Iwi Chairs Forum (NICF) Te Whare Pūkenga at the next Iwi Chairs hui in Ahuriri to be hosted by Ngāti Kahungunu in November 2024.

Te Whare Pūkenga was established in 2021 by Iwi Chairs Forum to recognise rangatira who have enhanced the lives of all whānau in Aotearoa. The accolade is given to someone whose actions embody the forum's values, including rangatiratanga, whanaungatanga, manaakitanga, kaitiakitanga, tikanga and pono.

The Iwi Chairs Forum has 86 members representing Iwi from across Aotearoa "Kotahitanga" is central. Te Whare Pūkenga accolade is an opportunity to acknowledge our Māori leaders shining a light on the pathway they have set for the next generation.

She was a member of the Rangitane o Wairarapa and Rangitāne o Tamaki nuia-Rua negotiation team which worked on and successfully completed their Treaty of Waitangi Deed of Settlement in 2016.

In Mavis's own words reflecting on Rangitāne Treaty Settlement on behalf of her people she said, "We needed to have the opportunity to rise, ensuring our footprint was evident from mountain to river to sea."

Mavis is a power house in business and thrives in governance leadership roles. Her mahi as a founding and influential entrepreneur for Te Huarahi Tika Trust spearheaded the launch of 2degrees in 2000 a business venture driven by Māori. She is a determined mana wahine working for the betterment of whānau, hapū, Iwi Māori and Aotearoa.

Mavis Mullins was inducted into the New Zealand Business Hall of Fame in 2017 named as an Outstanding Māori Business Leader. With a long list of accolades to her name being a wife, mama and grandmother is the greatest role of them all. Mavis and her husband Koro have four tamariki and 14 mokopuna. Mavis is a fifth-generation

farmer, her culturally rich grassroots, hardworking upbringing in the shearing sheds, her intelligence and swift thinking ability motivated by aroha has paved a successful career in business.

Rangitāne Tū Mai Rā are extremely proud to have one of our very own whānau Mavis Mullins he wahine maia, he wahine rangatira, he wahine toa. To be recognised and honoured by Te Whare Pūkenga alongside Maoridom's great warrior leaders like Tā Pita Sharples, Tā Timoti Karetu, and Liz Hunkin rangatira who have advocated and spearheaded the intergenerational revival of te reo Māori me ona tikanga throughout the establishment of Kōhanga Reo, Kura Kaupapa Māori, Wharekura and Te Ataarangi. Te Whare Pūkenga recognition of Te Ao Māori leaders is an achievement to be commended.

Mavis shared this korero reflection on one of the biggest roles she held for her people of Rangitāne, "I will always be there but it's time for the new leadership to come through I now want to spend more time watching mokopuna that I have and maybe doing some other cool stuff in governance and business." It needs to be noted this was said 5 years ago now, so like all leaders within Te Ao Māori, even with the fresh new leadership, you can never really turn away.
